Genesis 10:25

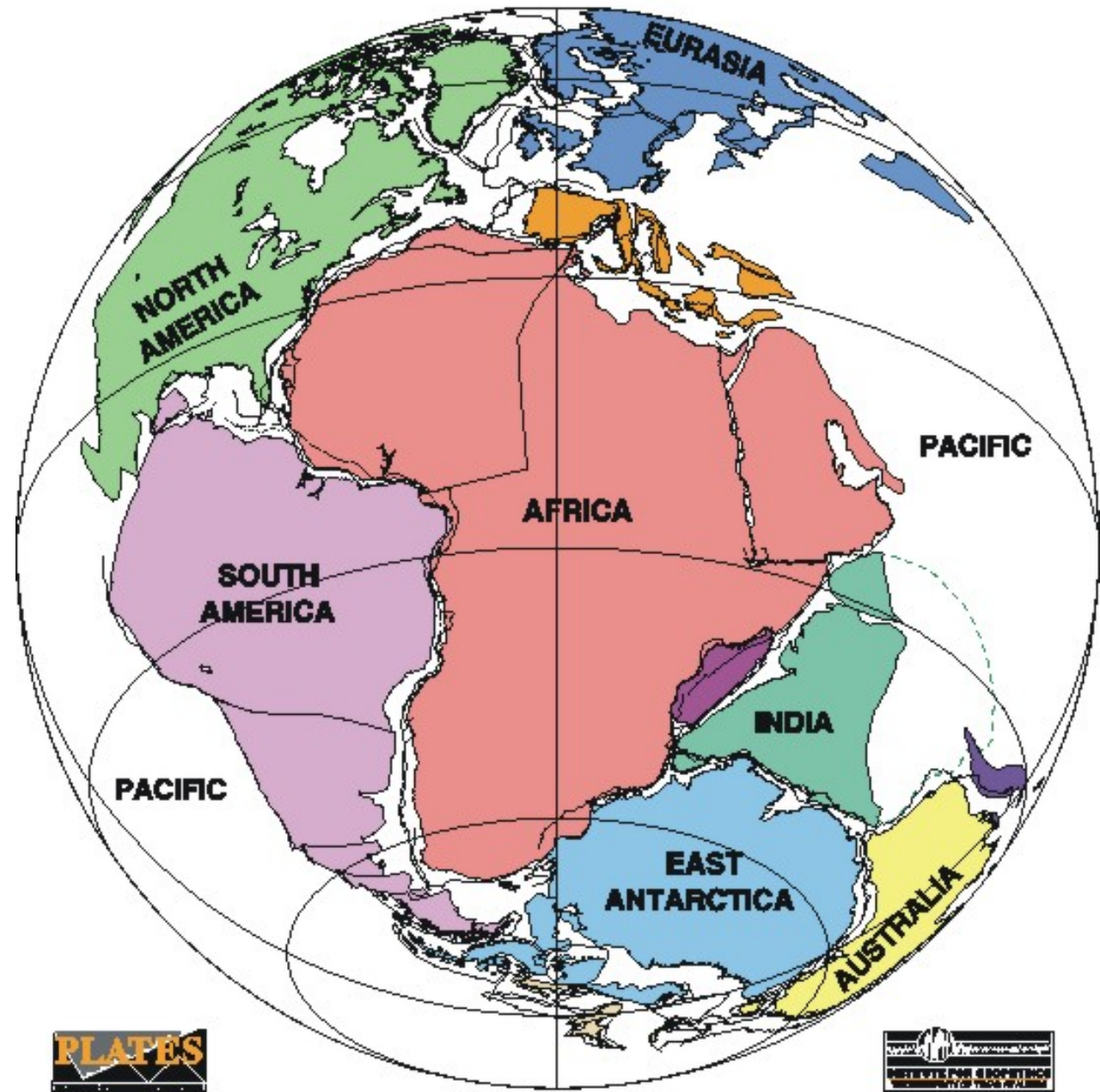
Eber had two sons. The first was named **Peleg** (which means "division"), for during his lifetime the people of the world were divided into different language groups. His brother's name was Joktan.

NIMROD

Genesis 10:8 ...the first heroic warrior on earth.

9 Since he was the greatest hunter in the world, his name became proverbial. People would say, "This man is like Nimrod, the greatest hunter in the world."

NIMROD

Genesis 10:10 He built his kingdom in the land of **Babylonia**, with the cities of **Babylon**, **Erech**, **Akkad**, and **Calneh**.

11 From there he expanded his territory to **Assyria**, building the cities of **Nineveh**, **Rehoboth-ir**, **Calah**,

12 and **Resen** (the great city located between **Nineveh** and **Calah**).
